



### **Arden Road Loop - 57 miles**

A few hills but no curves to speak of. The roadside is mostly ranch land brush and deserted. I would recommend going into Mertzton, turning east on the Sherwood Loop (Duncan Ave) and then catching County Road 211 till it dead ends back on Hwy 67. They is a short scenic county road with a few curves. Be sure and note the old abandoned Sherwood County Courthouse building on the right.

There is a lot of vehicle and bug truck traffic on 67. Traffic on the Arden Road loop almost non-existent

Good starting point: HEB fuel station 3301 Sherwood Way, Head west on Arden Road. There is no actual town of Arden. It's just a historical marker and a few houses. Once you pass Arden, the road takes a sharp left turn. Stay on this road till you hit US 67. You can turn right (south) and go 4 miles into Mertzton and then take the Sherwood loop back to US 67, or you can turn left and go directly to San Angelo. Fuel available in San Angelo and Mertzton.
